Commonly asked questions

When can I retire?

Normal retirement age begins at age 60. But, retirement may start any time after you reach age 50, or earlier if your age plus years of service total 75.

When should I start planning for retirement?

Ideally you should begin planning 5–10 years before you plan to retire.

I want to retire in the next 6 months. what should I do?

Reach out to a CSS Advisor to start the process and explore your retirement options.

I'm not sure when I want to retire. what should I do?

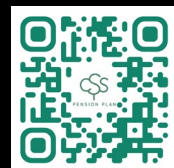
